SCHOLARSHIP DESCRIPTION:

The Mowing with a Meaning Scholarship is available to high school juniors and seniors who have applied to a school of higher learning, to attend upon graduation from said high school. This scholarship is available to high school students who themselves or their immediate family members have been diagnosed with a cancer of some form and has had to overcome the setbacks that has caused. This scholarship is designed for the individual who has not let cancer (of any form) keep them from their studies and desire to further their education.

Required Documents:

- Essay: (minimum 1,000 words)**
The required essay should state how cancer has affected you, how you have overcome and not let cancer define your future, as well as what goals you desire to pursue upon acceptance into a school.
- Doctor's Reference / Acknowledgement of Cancer**
- Current High School GPA & Transcript**
Any High School in Spalding, Pike, Butts, Lamar and Upson Counties
- Proof of Application to a School of Higher Learning**
- Three (3) Letters of Recommendation**
- Scholarship Application**

Scholarship will be delivered, directly to the school/college/university in the form of a one-time check upon acceptance/decision made by the scholarship recipient. The check will be delivered to the decided school at the start of the Fall freshman semester upon approval from the Board of Directors for Mowing with a Meaning. Scholarship is not renewable but recipient can reapply each year and will not be discriminated or favored based on previous winnings.
